## Technologies we use

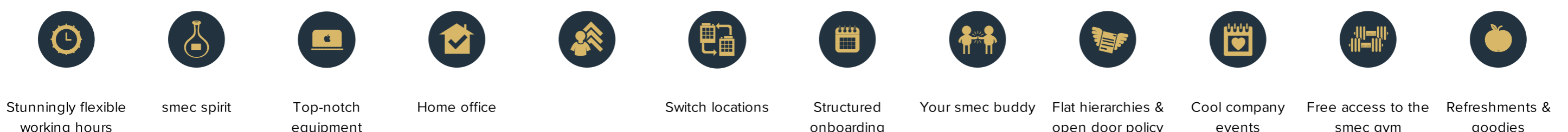
